The software supports single as well as combined forms and impresses due to its fast operation, based on defined templates and through automatic segmentation. 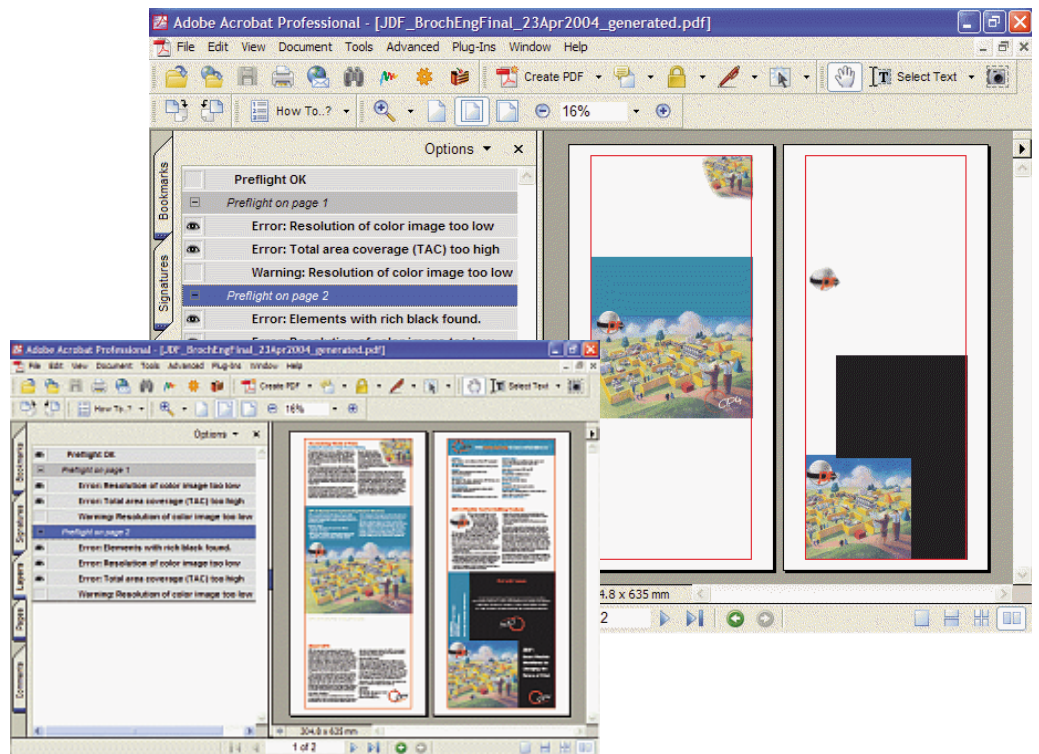
